As a Visiting Affiliate Assistant Professor in the Writing Department at Loyola University Maryland, I strive to be a versatile colleague with a variety teaching interests that span creative writing, composition and writing center studies. My degree area is Creative Writing, where I hold both a Master of Fine Arts degree and a PhD with an emphasis in fiction. I am currently working on a historical novel. Published work can be found in *Necessary Fiction*, *Dark Lane Quarterly Collective*, *The Toucan Literary Magazine*, *The Burnside Review*, and *Chrysalis* among others.

I also have extensive experience teaching composition and administrating Writing Centers. As Graduate Writing Center Coordinator, my responsibilities include training and supervision of our staff of graduate tutors, development and promotion of a graduate writing workshop curriculum, and collaboration with graduate faculty to provide program specific writing support. I also have conducted qualitative research in the field and presented those results, while serving in positions of departmental leadership as a complement to my teaching. I currently have a book-length academic textbook on peer tutor training under review with the Macmillan Learning division of Bedford/St. Martins.
